Bonaire Xtreme Duo MTB

Following the movement of Xtreme Duo mountain bike races in Aruba and Curacao, Bonaire Wellness Connexions has decided to organise a similar race to be held on Bonaire on Sunday October 24, 2010 at 7am.

The race course is 75km long and includes most single-tracks located in the north-east part of Bonaire. During the race, riders will follow some paved roads which will be carefully watched by volunteers; they will control the traffic and will make riders feel safe.

Single-tracks and safe dirt roads cover about 90% of the total race course. The route includes technical single-tracks in Washington National Park, windy and rough trails along the east coast, coral-stone trails through Lagoen and Bolivia and the challenging climb of Seru Largu at the end. Please check our website www.bonairewellness.com to see the race course on a Google Earth picture.

Participants must have teams of two riders (Duo). Duo can be man and woman, two men or two women. Both participants (Duo) must finish the race and the time that counts is the one taken from the rider who crosses the finish line last. There will be prizes for the first five winners of the race. Winners will receive trophies and cash prizes in some categories.

We kindly ask participants to register in advance in order for us to get transfers and accommodations organised in time. All participants coming from outside Bonaire will be picked up at the airport and transferred to the hotel.

Directions to the race

The race will start on the main street of Sabadeco. If you are in town, the easiest way to get there is to drive north always on the main street (Kaya Gobernador N. Debrot) until you get to Sabadeco. From Divi Flamingo Hotel to the start is about 5 minutes drive or 15 minutes by bike. You will find the start right on the main street of Sabadeco.

Race Support

Drinks stations will be situated throughout the course and at the start/finish. Water will be provided either in cups or small plastic bags. If a rider becomes distressed or have a crash, officers will be on hand to care for him/her.

Important Notice: Please note that Bonaire will no longer be part of the Netherlands Antilles as per October 10, 2010. Therefore, the Bonaire customs office has advised us that all participants from abroad, flying to Bonaire with a personal bicycle for the Xtreme race, will have to be on a list that they will keep at the airport for customs control. We advise all leaders of cycling clubs, teams, etc that are coming to Bonaire to the Xtreme to provide us with a list of participants (including name, country of origin, flight number, arrival and departure time, bicycle year, model and cost) so that we can give it to the customs department at the airport. Please note that customs will NOT let you pass if you are not on the list. Organizers are not responsible for those that did not register in advance and/or didn't provide all the requested information.
